

OHSCompliance Practical Checklist

Hazardous Chemical Compliance South Africa: SDS, PPE and Training

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How to use this checklist:

- Use it before requesting a quote, uploading a safety file or preparing for a client review.
- Do not upload private learner records, ID numbers or certificate copies through public channels.

Client audit readiness:

- Confirm the chemical inventory is current and linked to SDS records.
- Check storage compatibility, labels, decanting controls and spill readiness.
- Match PPE issue records to SDS requirements and actual exposure.
- Link HAZCHEM training to the workers who handle, store, decant or transport chemicals.

Documents to prepare:

- Chemical inventory: Shows what substances are on site and where they are stored. Owner: Stores, supervisor o
- SDS register: Gives hazard, PPE, storage and emergency information. Owner: Chemical owner or OHS coordinator
- Storage compatibility checklist: Reduces incompatible storage and spill risk. Owner: Stores or supervisor. U
- HAZCHEM training matrix: Links exposed workers to practical chemical training. Owner: Training coordinator.
